If you are planning to ship wedding materials to Mexico through a courier, please take the next two points into consideration:

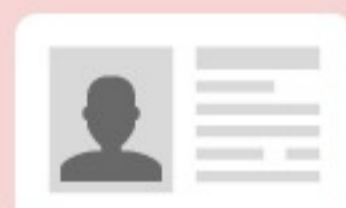


1. Import requirements in Mexico:

The maximum amount allowed to be imported into Mexico by these companies is US\$999.99 per shipment.



If the value of the shipment is higher, a Mexican Tax ID number and Import License will be required.



Hotels in Mexico DO NOT have the appropriate Import License for the permanent or temporary imports of their guests.



Resorts are usually not allowed to pay import taxes for the imports of their guests, as they are not tax-deductible.

2. Highly restricted products

Regardless the shipment value, the products listed below are subject to import restrictions pursuant to Mexican law. In such cases an Import License will be mandatory for customs clearance, and also the shipment will be subject to a lengthy process to obtain the appropriate permits.

- Candles
- Sand & Seashells
- Food and perishables
- Ceramic / Porcelain articles: Pottery, dishes, crockery, cups, pepper/salt shakers, etc.

- Sandals and Footwear
- Wines, beverages and any liquid
- Toys, beach balls and balloons
- Used clothes and personal effects
- First aid kits and medicines
- Products made in China (high taxes)

Highly restricted materials are not limited to this list. Here we are listing the most common products we have identified with high taxes or pre-requisites applied.
