For Shipping Internationally



AVOID "OVERNIGHT" SHIPPING SERVICES

International shipments are subject to foreign customs procedures which sometimes may take longer, no matter what courier offered.







CHOOSING YOUR BOXES

Under-filled boxes will collapse

Overloaded boxes will burst, even if they are strapped

It is better to use smaller and more lightweight boxes



Remove old address labels and delivery

Be sensitive about the weight of the items you put markings in a box

Use new, rigid, top quality boxes for packing



Use the appropriate size of packaging for the items being shipped



Consider the strength and durability of your packing materials



Keep the contents confidential



CAUTIONARY MEASURES WHEN SHIPPING HIGH-VALUE PRODUCTS

Use personalized tape

to make sure your box wasn't open

in transit

Use double boxing method to pack the contents.

Use security seals, special use bags, cable ties, security shipping tapes, security cases and any other means to prevent theft of goods.

Use black shrink film

Let us know the tracking numbers when shipping to our warehouse so we can keep the boxes tracked 1234 5678 9012 3456



USE DIVIDERS

dividers, which provide absorption to shocks









Edge protectors are available in plastic and recycled cardboard

Avoid packing kits





FRAGILE ITEMS To protect items, use at least two inches of appropriate cushioning material...

-Place the label on a flat surface on the side of the package -Place only one address label on the box

-Insert a duplicate label inside the package
